**ABOUT RUSS PRATT**

Dr Russ Pratt has over 20 years' experience working therapeutically with sexual assault and abuse, trauma, attachment, family systems and child protection issues. From 2010 until 2017 he was one of two Statewide Principal Practitioners with the Department of Health and Human Services Child Protection program. Prior to that was manager and senior clinician of the AWARE program for sexually abusive youth at SECASA. He holds specialist registration as both a Forensic and Counselling psychologist. He was a member of the Therapeutic Treatment Board (a Ministerial appointment) from 2012 to 2017 and is a current member of the NSW Children's Guardian's Expert Advisory Panel, an ANZATSA board member, a Fellow of ATSA (USA), and a board member of the National Adolescent Perpetrator Network (USA). Russ regularly writes and presents both nationally and internationally regarding youth exhibiting sexually abusive behaviours, the impacts of pornography on sexual practice, and other issues.

Russ is currently undertaking research with Cyra Fernandes (ACF) on therapists' views on the impact of pornography on sexually abusive youth. He can be seen and heard regularly in print, and on television and radio, as he is a popular interviewee and speaker on the topics of sexual abuse, pornography and trauma.
